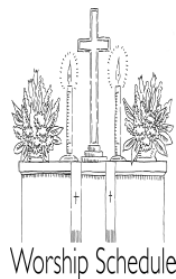

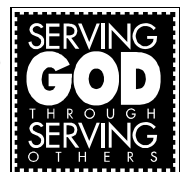

Ash Wednesday

Ash Wednesday is not a holy day of obligation. Nevertheless you are encouraged to attend. It is however a day of fast and abstinence.

Catholics in good standing who are age 14 and older are obligated to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Fridays of Lent. In addition, on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, Catholics from age 18-59 fast, limiting themselves to one full meal and two smaller meals each day.
